## "Acts" LifeGroup Study Questions

**Prepare and Pray** • Say a simple prayer inviting the Holy Spirit to speak as you study God's Word.

Read this week's Bible passage
In this series, we will consider how "Evangelism is an Act of Delight." Let us memorize Acts 1:8 (NIV) as our theme verse. A question to ask is "Who is the protagonist in the book of Acts?" Jesus Chris, the Holy Spirit, or Christ's followers. Please consider what relationship they have with one another.
Observe – List the facts of this passage (what is happening, who is involved). Consider four themes: Jesus, Holy Spirit, prayer, and witness. Are there any Old Testament references? What is the message that the disciple proclai? How is conversion worded if any?
Interpret – What is the main point of this passage? Ask questions like • Is there a command to obey? • Is there a promise to claim? • Is there a warning to heed? • What does it mean to witness? What do we learn about the role of the Holy Spirit and the believers, if any, in witnessing? Why is this bible story important?
Summarize in one sentence what God is saying in this passage.
<b>Apply</b> – Before you proceed, please stop and ask God to tell you how to apply this lesson. Please take 3 minutes in silence to simply listen. The goal is to obey God. God often asks us to do something beyond our comfort level because "the righteous faith shall live by faith."
How will you apply this lesson?
<b>Pray</b> in response to the Lord. Pray that you will apply this lesson to your life this week. Ask for God's help to witness to 2 people in the next two months. Pray for insight on how you can help people experience the goodness

of God's good news. Plead that their eyes would see God's goodness in Jesus.
